

RULES of SCHULER PERFORMING ARTS CENTER

And General Theater Etiquette

- Food and drink are not allowed on stage or in the seating area. Water in a lidded container is permitted only with express permission from the stage manager. Even just spilling water on any drape can cause permanent damage usually requiring the drape to be replaced.
- **Group** meals or snacks are not allowed on campus without the express permission of the North Idaho College catering department. To make arrangements for food service call 208-769-7771. Please make arrangements for appropriate catering locations with the stage manager.
- No glue, tape or other adhesive should be brought into the building without first consulting the stage manager. We will work with you for best applications and practices.
- Spray paint is not allowed anywhere in the building. Please do not use spray paint outside on the sidewalks. If you have special needs then please contact a stage technician before you do anything. All painting should be done prior to "load-in". Emergency painting will require permission and accommodations.
- No wet paint is allowed on stage or in the building.
- Please avoid touching the draperies. The Grand Drape should **never** be touched.
- When the Grand drape is closed please do not attempt to pass through it without assistance from a house technician. Do not walk around the edge of the Grand Drape. This is not a clear path to the stage.
- Please avoid touching or setting scenery near the Cyclorama Curtain. Items falling into the Cyclorama could tear or "dent" the fabric. You may be charged for replacement.
- Glitter and other particulate in the carpeted areas are expressly discouraged. You may be charged additional cleaning fees.
- Please do not borrow chairs and other items from classrooms or rearrange classrooms without permission. Do not bring any furniture onto the stage without the stage manager's knowledge.
- Do not touch items or tools not pertaining to your show or event
- Please do not climb over the seats in the house
- Do not set cases or other items on the green room furniture. We can provide many storage options and locations for your gear.
- All children must be directly supervised by a parent or other adult.
- Please do not set anything on any of the grand pianos in any of the rooms. A piano is not a table.
- Please notify the stage manager prior to bringing any type of weaponry onto the campus or into the theater. This includes prop guns, wooden swords and other completely harmless props if they have a weapon-like appearance.

Schuler Performing Arts Center and Boswell Hall are over 30 years old. Because of these rules you have a beautiful space in which to perform. Please help us keep it this way for another 30 years.
